A New Nose
"Looking at the shadows along her nose, it is very probable she has undergone a nose job," says Beverly Hills plastic surgeon Dr. Payman Simoni. Average cost: \$4,500.

Plumped Lips
"It appears she has had a lip filler, since her upper lip appears larger now than her lower lip," says Beverly Hills plastic surgeon Dr. William Bruno. "This ranges from \$500 to \$700 and lasts up to one year."

Sure, every bride hopes she'll walk down the aisle looking absolutely perfect — but Jessica Simpson is getting a little extra help in that quest. The singer recently shed an astonishing 70 pounds through Weight Watchers and workouts, leaving her in the best shape of her life. With just days to go until she ties the knot over the Fourth of July weekend, that should've been enough. But she didn't stop there — not by a long shot. In addition to her weight loss, Jess "has relied on some cosmetic surgery procedures to look her best for the wedding," reveals a pal. The problem? Those procedures have backfired, according to experts. "Overall," says Beverly Hills plastic surgeon Dr. Payman Simoni, "Jessica's experience with plastic surgery does not appear to be flattering."

DON'T EVER CHANGE
If it were up to Jess, insiders say she may have gone even further. But her husband-to-be, Eric Johnson, 34, wanted her to stop. "He tells her when she's looking too frozen," says an insider. "He'd definitely object to her getting any significant plastic surgery, like a boob job or tummy tuck."

TOO MUCH WORK?
What did she have done? According to sources and experts, Jess, 33, used Botox and fillers to smooth out her face and lip injections to plump up her pout. Then, to blast away any traces of fat remaining after her sessions with trainer Harley Pasternak, Jess had some fat-freezing procedures over the past few months. Dr. Jeffrey Wise, facial plastic surgeon and clinical professor of plastic surgery at New York University, estimates she's had more than \$16,000 worth of procedures in total, including skin-tightening and laser resurfacing. "She worked hard to get her body back," explains the insider, "but there were still some things she was insecure about."
